

Supply List for "Landscape Painting Fundamentals" Instructed by Matt Smith

- A good outdoor painting box.
Strada, Open Box M, Alla Prima Pochade or French Easle.
- A solid tripod for the paint box.
Monfrotto, MeFoto, Gitzo, etc...
- A pack to carry it all in.

- The following is a list of the paint I use. All colors are Holbein unless noted otherwise.

- Titanium White (Utrecht), Cobalt Blue Pale, Ultramarine Blue Deep, Viridian Hue, Cad Yellow Lemon, Cad Yellow, Yellow Ochre, Cad Orange, Alizarin Crimson, Burnt Sienna, Mauve Blue Shade (Winsor and Newton), Thalo Yellow Green (Grumbacher), Thalo Blue (any brand), Cerulean Blue Hue (Grumbacher).
- Hog bristle brushes. I prefer Silver (brand name) Grand Prix flats #2,4 and 6.
 - A small painting knife.
 - Several small panels, 8"x10" to 12"x16". Plan on painting two works a day. I prefer "SourceTek" oil primed panels and favor their Claessens #66 on 1/8" plywood.
 - Please don't bring any painting mediums. GAMSOL ONLY!
 - Plenty of paper towels and trash bags.
 - Painting reference, either photos or field paintings.
