DATES TO REMEMBER

Deliver Artwork - Monday, July 24, 11 a.m. - 1p.m.

Reception and Awards - Saturday, July 29, 2-4 p.m.

Pick Up Artwork - Monday, August 28, 9 - 11 a.m.

Eligibility: *Images* is open to all KACC Member levels 1 and up. Each member may submit UP to THREE PIECES. Any original artwork in any medium created within the last two years and not previously shown at KACC, is eligible. Artwork that has been done under instruction or where source photos are not those of the artist, is ineligible. Artwork based on patterns or kits is not permitted. KACC is a family friendly art center and work should be appropriate for all audiences. Artwork must be no larger or heavier than one average person can carry.

Membership: Non-members who have not previously been KACC members may enter at the 'non-member' rate and participate in this show. The rate will include a one year membership. Visit www.kacckerrville.com for membership details.

Entry Fee: Current members \$25 for up to 3 pieces and \$65 for non-members. Diptychs and triptychs may be subject to special size limitations, must be priced as one, and must be clearly a single work of art. Entry fee is non-refundable whether or not pieces are selected by the juror

Categories: Paintings on canvas/panel, Paintings on Paper, Drawing, Other 2-D, Sculpture, Fiber, Jewelry, Other Fine Craft, Photography. Artists will select the category of their entries, however, the judge has the option to re-categorize.

Display Criteria: Artwork must be properly prepared for display. 2-D work must be framed and wired using non-coated wire with ends taped. Glass larger than 16 X 20 is **only** allowed on pastels/charcoal. All fiber, jewelry or other fine craft must be equipped with a proper and secure method of hanging or display appropriate for the respective medium. Display cases will be available for jewelry or very small pieces. 3-D work must sit firmly on a base and be without sharp or otherwise hazardous edges or projections.

Jury Process: Jury process will begin promptly at 1 p.m. on Monday, July 24. Artists will be notified by end of day if any pieces were not selected. Pieces not selected must be picked up on Tuesday morning, July 25 before noon.

Awards: The Carolyn McBride Memorial Award will be awarded to the artwork judged BEST OF SHOW. Ribbons will be awarded in each category. Other cash and merchandise may be awarded. All awards will be at the judge's discretion. The judge's decisions are final.

Sales: KACC retains 30% commission on sales of artwork. Artists will be paid by the 15th of the next month following the sale.

Juror: KATHLEEN COOK, PSA, Kerrville, Texas

Kathleen Cook was born in Amarillo, Texas. After earning a Bachelor of Fine Art degree from Texas Tech University, her professional art career includes twelve years as a fashion illustrator and advertising art director and since 1981, she has been a full-time painter. Kathleen produces paintings for competitive exhibitions, gallery representation and portrait commissions. She also teaches figure and still-life workshops and is a traveling guest instructor and juror for numerous art groups and workshop facilities. She is well-versed in the principles of design and concept and how they contribute to making exciting artworks in any medium.

Kathleen Cook is an elected signature member of the *Pastel Society of America* in New York and her paintings have received over 40 major national and international awards. Kathleen Cook's pastel paintings have been featured in *American Artist*, *Southwest Art*, *Pastel Highlights* and *Pastel Artist International* magazines. She is also listed in *Who's Who in American Art*.
